State Statute 121.11, known as the Sunshine Act, requires public officials to take official action and conduct all deliberations upon official business only in open meetings, unless the subject is specifically excepted by law. Meeting dates and times published in the book are the regular sessions of the public body. Circumstances may change these dates and give reason for special meetings. We suggest the public body be contacted for verification of meeting dates and requirements for notifications.

Where available E-mail, web addresses, and 2010 census population figures have been included.

HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR PUBLIC OFFICIALS

LETTERS

Letters, fax and e-mail messages are often important in influencing action. Public officials are more likely to respond to an individually worded letter or card.

Handwritten letters are fine if they are readable, but typewritten letters are preferable. Include your address and sign your name. If there is a family, business, or a political connection related to the issue, explain the connection. This may serve as identification when your point of view is considered.

If you are writing about a particular bill, identify it by number or title if you can. (See page 3 for telephonenumber for up-to-date state and federal legislative information.)

Be courteous and reasonable. Being rude or threatening is nonproductive.

Keep your letter short. Write out only one point in one letter. Be specific about the action you urge. Indicate one or more reasons for your position. Be concise, direct and factual in your presentation.

Be sure your representatives know your point of view. They cannot reflect your position if it is not clearly understood.

Public officials hear most often from constituents who oppose their actions. Write to say you approve of an action, not just to complain or oppose.

REGISTERING TO VOTE

In order to register, you must be:

1. A citizen of the United States, and
2. At least 18 years old on or before the day of the next general election*, and
3. You will be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before an election.

You can register online at the Ohio Secretary of State's website: <https://olvr.sos.state.oh.us/orvu/ModifyAddress.aspx>. To use the online registration system you must provide an Ohio Driver's License number or State Identification Card number in addition to your name, date of birth, and last four digits of your Social Security number. If you don't have this information, you may still register to vote by using the paper form as described below.

You may register year-round at all Boards of Elections, public libraries, high schools, Human Services Departments, and license bureaus. Also, virtually every municipal and township office will accept registrations.

Registration forms may be requested by mail or telephone from your County Board of Elections, printed from Board of Elections websites shown below or picked up at any agency authorized to register voters. The deadline for registering to vote in an election is 30 days prior to the election.

If you have changed your name or address since you last voted, you must update your registration by the same process as a new registration, either online or by completing paper form.

In Montgomery County you may check your registration status on-line. Go to www.mcboe.org and click on "Am I registered to vote?"

In Greene County you may check your registration on line at www.co.greene.oh.us/boe/ and click on "voter lookup."

*Note that this means a registered 17-year-old voter is qualified to vote in candidates' races only (not on issues) even before attaining age 18 as long as the voter will be 18 by general election day. Contact the Board of Elections or the League of Women Voters for details.

DID YOU KNOW THAT . . .

The polls are open from 6:30 AM to 7:30 PM.

You do not have to declare a political party to register. Voters declare their party at the polls **only** if they wish to vote in a **primary election** for candidates of their party. If you do not wish to declare a party, you are entitled to vote on issues only.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting allows you to vote 29 days before a Primary Election and a General Election.

A qualified Ohio voter does not have to state a reason to vote by an absentee ballot, although the ballot must be applied for in writing. If you are properly registered to vote, you must submit your written request to the board of elections by mail or hand delivery. Faxed applications are NOT accepted.

You may print an absentee ballot application from the Board of Elections websites shown below or send a written request.

The request must give the following information:

- Your name and voting residence.
- The election for which you are requesting a ballot.
- Your party choice, **IF** the election is a Primary, or that you want to vote an issues-only ballot.
- The mailing address to which you want your ballot sent.
- Your date of birth.
- Your Ohio driver's license OR the last four digits of your social security number OR another acceptable form of voter identification.
- Your complete legal signature or mark.

If you are serving on active duty in the U.S. armed forces outside the state, you, your spouse and dependents may vote by an armed service absentee ballot if you otherwise meet the requirements for voting in Ohio. Your spouse and dependents may vote by an armed service absentee ballot only if they left Ohio to be with you.

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

The forms of identification that may be used by a voter who appears at a polling place to vote on an Election Day include:

- A current and valid photo identification card issued by the State of Ohio or the United States government; or
- A military identification (“military ID”); or
- An original or copy of a current utility bill; or
- An original or copy of a current bank statement; or
- An original or copy of a current government check; or
- An original or copy of a current paycheck; or
- An original or copy of a current other government document, other than a voter registration acknowledgement notification mailed by the board of elections, that shows the voter’s name and current address.

A voter presenting an Ohio driver’s license that shows the voter’s former address is permitted to cast a regular ballot so long as the voter’s current residential address is printed in the official poll list of registered voters for that precinct. Voters who do not provide one of these documents at the precinct will still be able to vote using a provisional ballot. Voters who do not have any of the above forms of identification, including a Social Security number, will still be able to vote by signing an affirmation statement swearing to the voter’s identity under penalty of election falsification and by casting a provisional ballot.

If you cast a provisional ballot because you did not provide acceptable proof of identity at the time of voting, you must appear in person at the board of elections to provide such proof within 10 days after Election Day in order for your ballot to be counted. Proof of identity may be any of the documents listed above OR the last four digits of your Social Security number OR a signed affirmation statement (provided by the board of elections) stating that you do not have any of the above items.

CAUTION: Voting requirements, including absentee ballots, ID requirements, and early voting schedules may be changed by legislative action. For the most current information, check with your County Board of Elections or the Ohio Secretary of State website: www.sos.state.oh.us/sos/elections.aspx.

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
