State Statute 121.11, known as the Sunshine Act, requires public officials to take official action and conduct all deliberations upon official business only in open meetings, unless the subject is specifically excepted by law. Meeting dates and times published in the book are the regular sessions of the public body. Circumstances may change these dates and give reason for special meetings. We suggest the public body be contacted for verification of meeting dates and requirements for notifications.

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HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR PUBLIC OFFICIALS

LETTERS

Letters, fax and e-mail messages are often important in influencing action. Public officials are more likely to respond to an individually worded letter or card.

Handwritten letters are fine if they are readable, but typewritten letters are preferable. Include your address and sign your name. If there is a family, business, or a political connection related to the issue, explain the connection. This may serve as identification when your point of view is considered.

If you are writing about a particular bill, identify it by number or title if you can. *(See page 7 for telephone numbers for up-to-date state and federal legislative information.)*

Be courteous and reasonable. Being rude or threatening is nonproductive.

Keep your letter short. Write out only one point in one letter. Be specific about the action you urge. Indicate one or more reasons for your position. Be concise, direct and factual in your presentation.

Be sure your representatives know your point of view. They cannot reflect your position if it is not clearly understood.

Public officials hear most often from constituents who oppose their actions. Write to say you approve of an action, not just to complain or oppose.

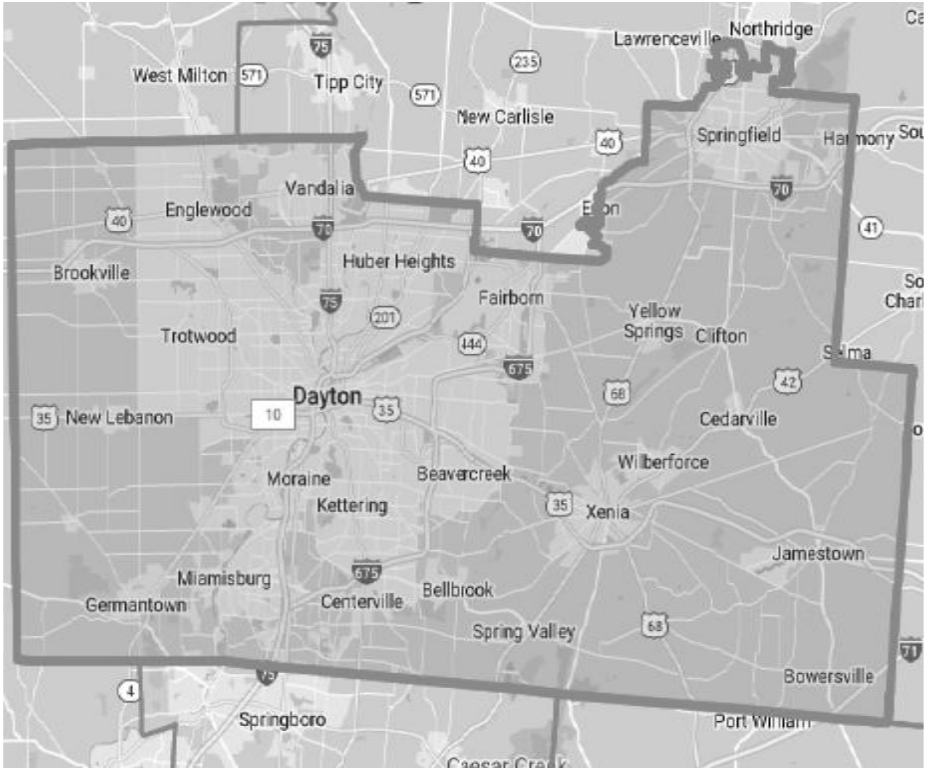

All of Montgomery County is contained in the 10th Ohio Congressional District. The district also includes all of Greene County and the southern part of Clark County, including the City of Springfield.

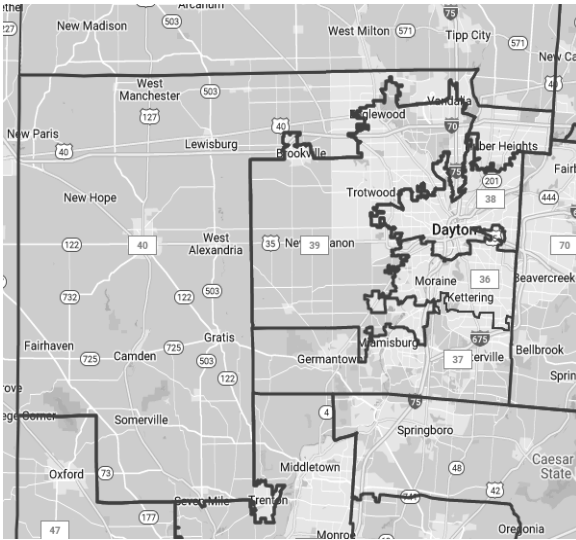

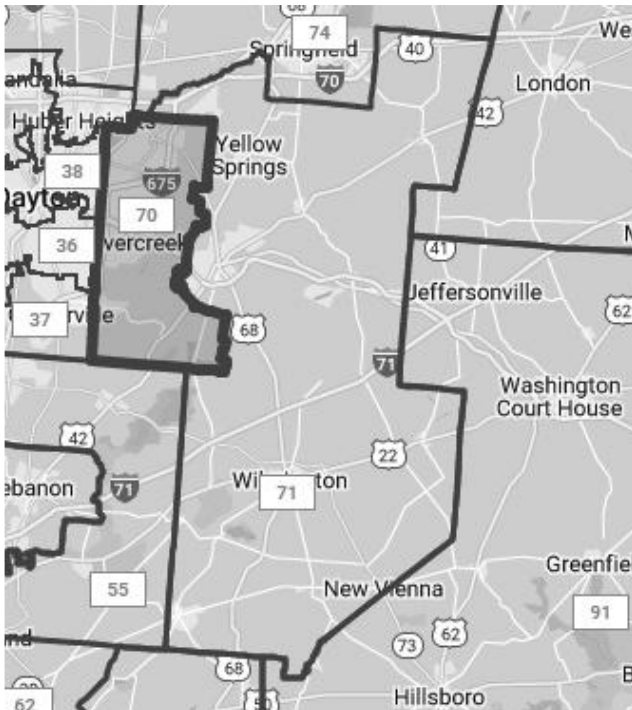

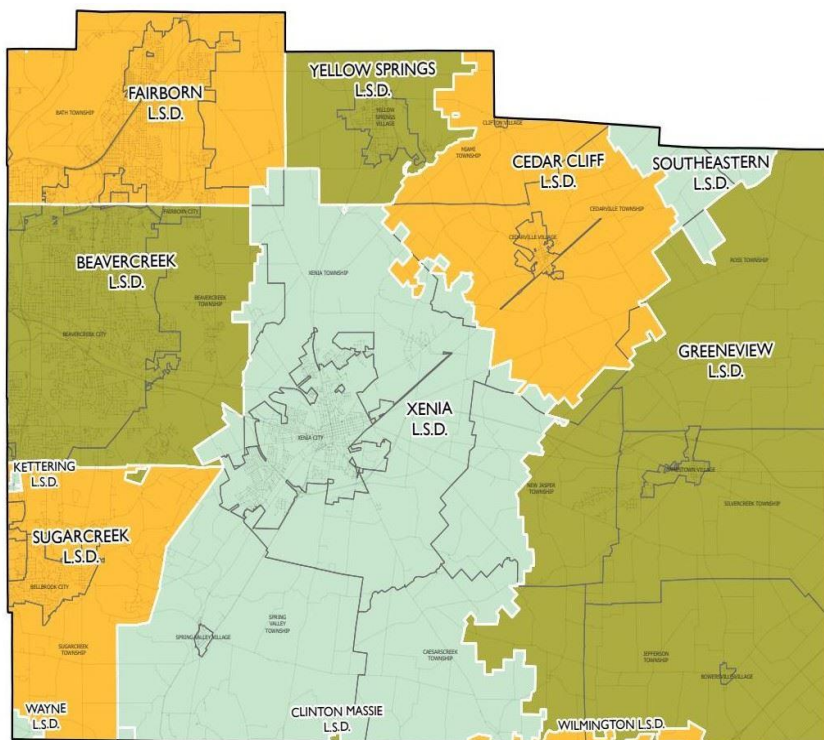

REGISTERING TO VOTE

In order to register, you must be:

1. A citizen of the United States
2. At least 18 years old on or before the day of the next general election*
3. A resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before an election. **

You can register online at the Ohio Secretary of State's website: <https://olvr.ohiosos.gov>. To use the online registration system you must provide an Ohio Driver's License number or State Identification Card number in addition to your name, date of birth and last four digits of your Social Security number. If you don't have this information, you may still register to vote by using the paper form as described below.

You may register year-round at all Boards of Elections, public libraries, high schools, Human Services Departments, and license bureaus. Also, virtually every municipal and township office will accept registrations.

Registration forms may be requested by mail or telephone from your County Board of Elections, printed from the Board of Elections websites shown below or picked up at any agency authorized to register voters. The deadline for registering to vote in an election is 30 days prior to the election.

If you have changed your name or address since you last voted, you must update your registration by the same process as a new registration, either online or by completing a paper form.

In Montgomery County you may check your registration status online. Go to <https://www.montgomery.boe.ohio.gov/> and click on "VOTERS".

In Greene County you may check your registration online at <https://www.boe.ohio.gov/greene> and click on "Voter Registration Information"

*Note that this means a registered 17-year-old voter is qualified to vote in candidates' races only (not on issues) even before attaining age 18 as long as the voter will be 18 by the day of the general election. Contact the Board of Elections or the League of Women Voters for details.

** Note that this means that a person who has been an Ohio resident for less than 30 days can register to vote as long as the voter will have been an Ohio resident for at least 30 days by the day of the election.

DID YOU KNOW THAT . . .

On Election Day, the polls are open from 6:30 AM to 7:30 PM. You do not have to declare a political party to register. Voters declare their party at the polls **only** if they want to vote in a **primary election** for candidates of their party. If you do not want to declare a party, you are entitled to vote on issues only.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting allows you to vote up to 29 days before primary and a general elections.

A qualified Ohio voter does not have to state a reason to vote by an absentee ballot. The only identification required is an Ohio drivers license or state ID number or the last four digits of the voter’s Social Security number.

To get an absentee ballot, you must be registered to vote at least 30 days before the election. You must submit an application to your county Board of Elections using the form prescribed by the Ohio Secretary of State. The form can be downloaded from the Board of Elections websites listed below, or you can call the Board of Elections and request that an application form be mailed to you. You must submit your application to the Board of Elections by mail or hand delivery at least seven days before the election. Faxed applications are NOT accepted.

If you are serving on active duty in the U.S. armed forces outside the state, you, your spouse and dependents may vote by an armed service absentee ballot if you otherwise meet the requirements for voting in Ohio. Your spouse and dependents may vote by an armed service absentee ballot only if they left Ohio to be with you.

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

Voter identification requirements have changed. **Photo identification is now required for in-person voting.**

Acceptable forms of photo identification include:

- Ohio driver's license
- State of Ohio ID card
- Interim ID form issued by the Ohio BMV
- A US passport or US passport card
- US military ID card
- Ohio National Guide ID card
- US Department of Veterans Affairs ID card

All photo IDs must have the following:

- An expiration date that has not passed
- A photograph of the voter
- The voter's name, which must substantially conform to the voter's name as it appears in the Poll List or in the Poll Book

The following documents are **NO LONGER ACCEPTABLE** as identification for voting purposes: utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document.

A voter presenting an Ohio driver's license that shows the voter's former address is permitted to cast a regular ballot so long as the voter's current residential address is printed in the official poll list of registered voters for that precinct. Voters who do not provide one of these documents at the precinct will still be able to vote using a provisional ballot.

Voters who cast a provisional ballot because they did not provide acceptable proof of identity at the time of voting must appear in person at the Board of Elections to provide such proof within 4 days after Election Day in order for their ballot to be counted. Proof of identity may be any of the documents listed above.

CAUTION: Voting requirements, including absentee ballots, ID requirements, and early voting schedules may be changed by legislative action. For the most current information, check with your County Board of Elections or the Ohio Secretary of State website ohiosos.gov/elections/voters/
